Although the three men figured prominently into the start of the Church in Thessalonica, Paul emphasized:

- That the Church is in God the Father & in the LORD Jesus
  Christ v. 1
- That grace & peace originate with God the Father & the LORD Jesus Christ v. 1
- That thanks & prayer ought to be lifted to God v. 2 is this your first response??
- That all service is performed in the sight of God the Father
  & in the LORD Jesus Christ v. 3

Focus should be on the Father & the Son
