The Church at Corinth did participate Rom 15: 25-28

What kind of attitude do you have when you give?

- James 4: 2- "...yet ye have not, because ye ask not."
- John 11: 22- "But I know even now, whatsoever thou wilt ask of God, God will give it thee"
- John 14: 13- 14- "And whatsoever ye shall ask in my name, that will I do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son. If ye shall ask any thing in my name, I will do it."
- Col 2: 9- 10- "For in him dwelleth all the fullness of the godhead bodily, and ye are complete in him, which is the head of all principality and power:"
- John 15: 7-9; 16-17
- John 16: 23- 24

Five attitudes of giving: Shirk- ignore

Shelve- put off

Shoulder- give in your own strength

Shed- give & stop

Share- ask for God's help

GRACE= God's help,

when we need it,

to accomplish His will

Giving proves your love to Jesus v. 7, 8, 11, 24
Abounding in:

- Faith
- Utterance
- Knowledge
- Diligence
- Love for the brethren
- Financial giving

All these require the

GRACE of God

Giving is Christ-like v. 9
Giving should be proportional v. 10-15

Ultimately, what you give shows the extent your faith in God's ability to provide your needs

Our giving should be cared for honestly v. 16-24

Three men were assigned and accountable for the money & gifts given for the relief of the saints in Jerusalem:

- Titus v. 16
- The brother v. 18
- Another brother v. 22

So they would be unblameable v. 20-21

So others would have confidence v. 22
